3. Anger-Dealt With

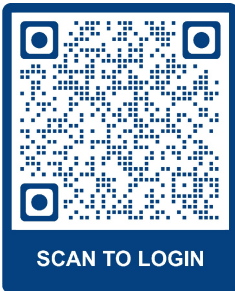
“And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, “The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and
